

Gwinnett Transit Referendum Scorecard

In July, the County Commissioners approved placing a one-cent sales tax to fund 82 transit projects on the November ballot. If passed, the funding would have raised over \$12 billion in funds and strengthened connectivity and coverage throughout the county while retaining local control. The Gwinnett Chamber Board of Directors approved a resolution in August in support of the transit referendum.
